



What will we be learning in term 3?

Year 1 ~ Back in Time

This term, in Year One, our work will include:

English	We will be reading the book Man on the Moon . We will be using artwork, drama and role-play to explore the story. We will be composing and rehearsing sentences orally before sequencing sentences to form short narratives. Children will re-read their writing to check it makes sense and make simple revisions.
Maths	We will be: • Learning to count within 20 • Understand numbers to 20. • Using a number line to 20. • Adding by counting on. • Finding number bonds to 20. • Doubles and near doubles. • Subtracting by counting back. • Subtracting using number bonds.
Topic	We will be learning about Mary Seacole, deciphering clues about this nineteenth century nursing pioneer. We will examine the role of nurses today and find out what qualities are needed to become a nurse. We will also learn how to avoid being ill through healthy eating and exercise and take the opportunity to create a healthy food plate. In art we will be learning about and creating a sculpture with clay. In computing we will be learning to programme a moving robot.
Science	We will be exploring a range of materials suitable for fixing a broken umbrella and testing them using a pipette to simulate raindrops. We will also be working with play figures frozen in ice, devising an investigation to release them. We will explore puddles and observe how they change, thinking carefully about what is happening: can you explain why a puddle changes?

Donaldson class will have swimming every **Tuesday** and PE every **Wednesday**.

Gray class will have PE every **Monday** and **Wednesday**.

Please remember children will now be wearing their PE kits to school on their PE days (not swimming days). Please remove your child's earrings on these days.
