I know the multiplication and division facts for the 5 times-table

By the end of this half term, children should know the following facts. The aim is for them to recall these facts instantly.

What can this look like?

4 multiplied by 5 = 20

$5 \times 10 = 50$ $50 = 10 \times 5$

40 divided by 5 = 8

$40 \div 5 = 8$

$$5 \times 1 = 5$$

$$5 \times 2 = 10$$

$$5 \times 4 = 20$$

$$5 \times 5 = 25$$

Key Vocabulary

Multiply: Adding *equal* groups a certain number of times, e.g. $5 \times 4 = 5 + 5 + 5 + 5 = 20$
Can also be referred to as **groups of** or **lots of**.

Divide: Sharing or grouping numbers/objects into *equal* groups, e.g. $10 \div 5 = 2$.

Things to Try

The secret to success is practising **little** and **often**. You could practise these KIRFs while walking to school or during a car journey. You do not need to practise them all at once; perhaps you could have a fact of the day.

Multiplication - Count in 5s or Multiply by 5 or 5 times-table facts

Division - Divide by 5 or 5 times-table
